Findings

OECD: Virtues of third places identified in rural areas

Europe: third places in all countries, several regional programmes and sectoral support (DG Grow, Rural Pact, Joint Research Centre, New Bauhaus)

France: Agenda France Ruralité (villages of the future, smart villages guide with the role of third places).

3,500 Third-Party Sites, €150 million, half of which for sparsely populated areas, 500 structures supported, 18 regional networks

Collective intelligence for creativity and innovation

Global understanding of the sum of individual interests

Empowerment of individuals, empowerment, emulation, emancipation

> Reappearance of positive-sum and shared-sum games

How can "local factories" serve smart villages?

- Bringing together players to meet the challenges of new technologies for production, marketing and distribution
- Rehabilitating the know-how and skills of local industries
- Relocating employment to local areas
- > Developing local production, the circular economy and reuse
- Developing distributed manufacturing
- Pooling investment around key local development issues: digital tools, databases, recipes, feedback, websites with shared resources, free access or accessible rates, participation in professional meetings, model statutes and contracts, agile methods (do it yourself, peer-to-peer, design thinking, living labs, etc.), etc.
