Rural Development is a two way process - it is not given, its shared...






Reduce, reuse, recycle

Can you be 'Smart' without a clear, strategic and dynamic plan?








"Planning is bringing the future into the present so that you can do something about it now...

Legacy impacts can only be achieved through multiannual planning (strategic).... But every journey starts with a first step - thus the importance of **Dynamic Short Term** (1 year and 1-5 year planning) within long term aims and objectives (15-20 Years)
