DEFINITION OF SMART VILLAGES

Smart Villages are defined as a tool to address societal challenges and transition issues, such as the energy transition or digital transition, through co-creation with village communities and rural actors and through social, digital and/or technological innovation. (BE-FL CAP SP, p. 1060)

Is there a focus on <u>digital innovation</u>? The definition refers to digital innovation as one of the means to address societal challenges and transition issues.

Is <u>rural area / village</u> defined? Rural areas are geographical, physical and socio-economical coherent areas consisting of at least three rural municipalities and as a whole have a population density equal to or less than 350 inhabitants/km² or a land take of maximum 30%. (BE-FL CAP SP, p. 346)

Is there a reference to <u>smart village strategies</u>? Within the thematic priority regarding vital and vibrant villages, LEADER Local Action Groups (LAGs) have the possibility to support the design and implementation of Smart Village Strategies that are considered "as a tool to address societal challenges and transition issues, such as the energy transition or digital transition, through co-creation with village communities and rural actors and through social, digital and/or technological innovation" (BE-FL CAP SP, p. 1051).

SO8: Promote employment, growth, gender equality

The aim is to "promote employment, growth, gender equality, including the participation of women in farming, social inclusion and local development in rural areas, as well as the circular bio-economy and sustainable forestry", with direct reference to smart villages, highlighting that "the quality of life in the countryside consists of several aspects. The LEADER intervention will inter alia respond to the smart transition of the rural economy (R.40) through Smart Village strategies" (BE-FL CAP SP, p. 214-215).

XCO: Cross-cutting objective of modernising the sector by fostering and sharing of knowledge, innovation and digitalisation in agriculture and rural areas

Reference is made to smart villages as follows: "LEADER is also working on the smart transition of the rural economy (R.40)" (BE-FL CAP SP, p. 241).

DEDICATED INTERVENTIONS

LEADER - design of local development strategies (3.18 and 3.19, COOP)

During the coming programming period the focus of local development through LEADER is on 3 thematic areas: 1) supporting a viable rural bioeconomy, 2) enhancing biodiversity and landscape quality, and 3) enhancing viability of villages and its communities. The ambition is to develop villages and communities that are future proof, divers and sustainable.

Within the theme of viable and vibrant rural villages, the LEADER intervention offers LAGs the possibility to design and implement smart village strategies: "the design and implementation of smart villages strategies as a tool to address societal challenges and transition issues, such as the energy transition or digital transition, through co-creation with village communities and rural actors and through social, digital and/or technological innovation" (BE-FL CAP SP, p. 1051). The LEADER intervention will contribute to result indicator R.40: 'Smart transition of the rural economy: Number of supported smart-village strategies'. Target values for this indicator are assessed once the local development strategies have been adopted. According to the assessed target values it will be possible to determine to what extent LEADER will focus on smart villages.
